SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING VIA CONFERENCE CALL APRIL 20, 2020

Council agreed to advertise the sale by tender of the surplus maintenance truck.

Moved by D. MacKinnon, seconded by J. Dumville and carried that purchase and sale agreement from Elite Homes for purchase of six lots at Pate Garden Subdivision be amended to extend the closure date to August 27, 2020 from May 13, 2020.

Moved by D. MacKinnon, seconded by V. Gallant and carried that potential building permit application from Deborah MacPherson for replacement of 6' x 8' rear porch be approved.

Bev to check on work plans for 567 Main Street, with WSP as to project time line, and with Andrew on changes to Town's website.
