The O'Leary Town Complex is opening on June 12, 2020.

Please do not enter if you have travelled out of PEI in the past 14 days or have any of the following COVID 19 symptoms: fever, new or worsening cough, sore throat, runny nose, sneezing, congestion or unusual fatigue.

If you're visiting the Town Office or Recreation Department, you will be expected to use the hand sanitizer as you enter the main door. Please check that the staff person is not busy with another customer before approaching the counter. There will be seats available in the hallway for you to use while waiting for your turn. Please stay 2 metres from people.

You will be asked to sign in and out as we track contacts for our staff and visitors.

If you're visiting the library, protocols are in place by the Provincial Library to place your order beforehand by phone or email, be notified of your order's arrival and a visit to pick up your order within the building but not in the library. There will be no computer use available. No used book sales.

We ask that all visitors refrain from using the washrooms in the facility. There will be no public gatherings in the Complex conference room this summer but allowances may be made for small meetings.
